Submission Policies

GEST invites researchers from around the globe to share their work with peers and industry. All abstract and trainee case submissions will undergo a blinded peer review for overall quality, novelty, impact, and execution.

Electronic Submission

All submissions must be submitted electronically via the GEST Abstracts/Trainee Cases submission website. Paper or emailed submissions will not be accepted.

Financial Disclosure

Author(s) will be required to complete a financial disclosure upon abstract/case acceptance. Industry cannot be presenters if the content of the abstract relates to the business lines and products of its employer.

Submission Types

Educational Poster:

An exhibit that depicts examples of a specific clinical scenario, explanation or description of a technique, management of a difficult clinical condition, or a novel management guideline for a disease.

Submission Format:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Background - Objective - Outlines (with Optional Chart/Table Upload; maximum of 2 total per submission) - Conclusion
Word Limit:	2,000 characters (including spaces)
Final Presentation:	Poster

Scientific Abstract (Poster and/or Oral):

A material that shows findings of a clinical research or basic science research which is completed based on testing a hypothesis and is being presented in the form of text, charts and/or figures.

Submission Format:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Background - Purpose/Objective - Materials & Methods (with Optional Chart/Table Upload; maximum of 2 total per submission) - Results (with Optional Chart/Table Upload; maximum of 2 total per submission) - Conclusion
Word Limit:	2,000 characters (including spaces)
Final Presentation:	Oral Presentation or Poster

Trainee Case Competition (Oral Only):

Open to all medical students, residents and fellows to share their interesting cases and have a chance to present amongst your peers at GEST 2023.

Submission Format:	- Clinical History/Chief Complaint of Present Illness (with Optional Chart/Table Upload) - Diagnosis, Treatment Options - Results/Intervention (with Optional Chart/Table Upload) - Outcomes
Word Limit:	2,500 characters
Final Presentation:	Oral Presentation

Submission Site Instructions

- Once registered on the online abstract submission portal, click 'Login' to begin your first submission.
- Complete account profile, moving forward you will be the contact person for all information that is submitted using this account. A confirmation email will be sent providing account details and personal information submitted.
- Begin a new abstract/case submission by clicking on the green text that reads "+ Click here to being a new submission".
- Follow the instructions listed for each relative section.

Accepted Abstracts/Cases

Oral Abstracts:

Selected abstracts will present at GEST 2023 in-person meeting and must register within two weeks of acceptance. Details on discounted registration will be provided upon acceptance notification.

Poster Abstracts:

Selected abstracts will be displayed as posters. The primary author must register within two weeks of acceptance.

Trainee Cases:

Selected trainee cases will present at GEST 2023 in-person and must register within two weeks of acceptance. Details on discounted registration will be provided upon acceptance notification.

Awards

Oral Abstracts:

The top oral abstracts will be selected to present at the Best of GEST Session during GEST 2023.

During the Best of GEST top abstracts session, the research committee will review all presentations and award the following at the end of the session:

- First place award: \$5,000USD
- Second place award: \$2,500USD
- Third place award: \$1,250USD

Posters:

All posters will be judged by the research committee and the top three posters will be recognized at the Best of GEST session.

Trainee Case Competition:

The top trainee cases will be selected to present in front of your peers for GEST 2023 and the Trainee Committee will select the top three cases to be recognized and awarded during the announcements at the end of the Best of GEST session.
